The Broadstone team played very well, finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> in the competition, but the behaviour and the attitude of our children was definitely the highlight of the afternoon. They were a credit to the school.

Sonny was awarded a special medal at the end of the competition for helping Lane End Primary.
