We are in an unprecedented period of cost inflation that brings with it many challenges. Our service delivery to Broadstone Hall Primary, and the sustained increases in the cost of food together with forthcoming changes to the Living Wage means that our current price per meal charged to school is not sustainable.

I want to assure you that we have tried to absorb as much of the unprecedented increases as we can, but unfortunately, I am having to write to you now as we manage our way through this difficult period.

We propose an increase in the school meal price from £2.15 to £2.25 be effective from the beginning of the Summer Term i.e., after your Easter holiday. We believe this still offers excellent value for your child to receive a nutritious hot meal each day.

I sincerely hope the economic situation improves for all business sectors and we look forward to providing a sustainable catering service for now and into the future. We do hope you understand the need for this change.
