What is Ramadan?

Ramadan is the Arabic name for the ninth month in the Islamic calendar. It is considered one of the holiest months for Muslims and is marked by a period of fasting, considered one of the **Five Pillars of Islam.**

These are five principles which Muslims believe are compulsory acts ordered by God: the other pillars are faith, prayer, charity and making the pilgrimage to the holy city of Mecca.

What does 'Eid Mubarak' mean?

'Eid' translates to English as 'celebration' whilst **'Mubarak'** means 'blessed' – so together the phrase means 'blessed celebration'.
