# Welcome to the Broadstone Hall Primary School Newsletter! **HEADTEACHERS NOTE:**

We would like to let you know about our "Pay It Forward Scheme" that we have now set up on ParentPay. It was a suggestion from one of our parents; and discussed again with our "Friends of Broadstone" Committee.

#### The simplest way to define "pay it forward" is when someone does something nice for you, instead of paying that person back directly, you pass it on to another person.

As a school, £1600 in total has been donated from school funds & FOB per year group to help subsidise school trips this academic year and lessen the financial burden for parents. For example: Christmas Panto costs £18 per child – but when subsidised; we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £10 per child.

However, should you feel in a financial position to pay the subsided amount to trips or any other variable amount in to the "Pay It Forward Scheme" it will always be open on ParentPay for whenever the gesture should take you. We thank you in advance for your kindness & generosity.

#### **RUGBY @ STOCKPORT RUGBY CLUB**




