Broadstone Hall Primary School Reopening of Afterschool Clubs November 2020

Dear Parents and Carers,

From Monday 2nd of November 2020, we are aiming to reopening our Afterschool Clubs.

However, due to Covid restrictions, this will have to be a very different service to the way the afterschool clubs have been run in the past. After careful consideration, including a site visit by Stockport LA Health and Safety Team, we have developed an approved plan that allows us to run a reduced service afterschool Clubs where the risk of spreading the Covid 19 virus is minimised.

We will be running the Afterschool Clubs for children from YR to Y6 but numbers will have to be significantly reduced and regulated to ensure that the risk of spread the virus is minimal. The clubs will run from 3.20pm – 4.30pm.

- **Daily Multisports Afterschool Clubs** specializing in a different sport every week (i.e. one week Basketball, the next Dodgeball, the next football for example)
- ONE PSCL Sports Coach PER BUBBLE
- Clubs will be on your child's allocated PE day, so they will already be in their PE kits
- Wednesday Year 5 Tri-Golf in partnership with Golf Schools Sports Partnership (£1 donation only)
- (TBC) Thursday Year 4 Guitar (a Broadstone Hall Club) conducted by Front Row Music
- (TBC) Friday Year 6 Ukulele (a Broadstone Hall Club) conducted by Front Row Music Please notify the school by 4.30pm 22nd October if you would like to sign up so we can see if the interest is there to viably run the music clubs.
- We will only be able to offer 15 places for each club PER YEAR GROUP
- Places must be booked & paid for in advance via Parentpay Broadstone Hall clubs are charged at £3.00 per session
- If your child cannot attend for any reason then the place will *not* be filled by another child. There will be no refund for non-attendance
- The children must be able to follow the rules. If they do not, they will not be allowed to attend Afterschool Clubs and this decision will be immediate and final.

Our Afterschool Clubs are charged half termly and are booked on a first come first serve basis. There are three full terms in the school year (Spring, Summer & Autumn.) Afterschool Clubs will always start the first week back of the term, and you can re-join again after the half-term break.

Afterschool Clubs will never run during the last week of a FULL term (Spring, Summer & Autumn)





ParentPay will open for bookings from Thursday 22nd October 2020 until Friday 6th November 2020.

<u>Places are limited and offered on a first come first serve basis, no further bookings will be</u> taken after this date - you will have to wait for the next half term to sign up again.

If a child tests positive for Covid 19, and they have had close contact with the children in their Afterschool Club bubble during the 48 hour period before they developed symptoms, then all the children in their Afterschool Club bubble (plus the infected child's class), will have to self-isolate for 14 days since their last contact.

If a member of staff test positive, then all groups that they have had close contact with during the 48 hour period before they developed symptoms, will have to self-isolate for 14 days since their last contact.
