What have we been learning in Maths?

At Broadstone Hall, we follow the White Rose scheme. This week we have been looking in more depth at the numbers 1, 2 and 3. We have been using Numberblocks to support our teaching. We have been exploring our number bonds (ways of making a number). We have used practical objects to see how numbers to 3 are made...ie 3 is made of 2 and 1, 3 and 0, or 1 and 1 and 1! Can you practice this at home with numbers 1-3?
