- Please make sure your child's blue book bag comes in every day.
- Please make sure that library books come back each week; Mondays for the Apples and Fruit Salads, Wednesday for the Pears.
- Please bring a named water bottle for your child with still water only <sup>(3)</sup>. They will keep this in their cubby.
