IT'S FLU SEASON

IntraHealth are concerned that the uptake on Flu vaccinations in our school were **100 children lower** than those who were vaccinated in school last year.

Therefore, they are offering a 3rd and final school visit as a catch-up for the flu vaccination.

Please note: Do not wait to go to your doctors. Most GPs will not have the allocated time to do the vaccination so this could be the only opportunity to receive the flu vaccination during this year's flu season.

Those children who have already received the vaccination do not need to consent as they should not be vaccinated again and those who do not respond will not have their children vaccinated as we only vaccinate with the consent of the parent/guardian.
