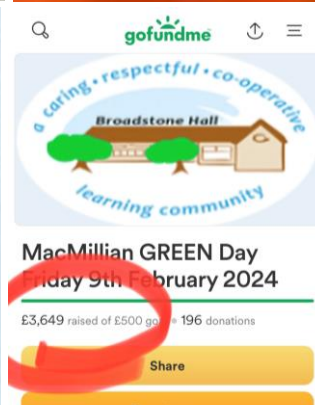
## HEADTEACHERS NOTE:
