FOB RAINBOW EASTER RAFFLE SUCCESS!

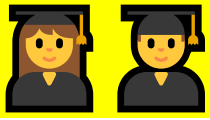

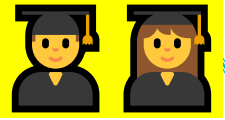
