### CURRICULUM WEB PAGES FOR SUMMER (1)

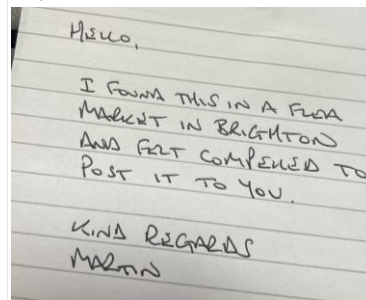
