When will I receive my order?

Can my child's sibling also take part in this project?

Absolutely. As long as the artworks have a unique artwork sticker on the reverse of them, you can create and order from as many artworks as you like. Once you have placed your order, you must hand in the extra artworks to the organiser so that it can be sent to APFS

Can I choose how my child's artwork can be printed on a mug?

Mugs can be printed with a choice of 2 layouts. There is a tiled design with the artwork reduced down in size and printed multiple times around the mug. Alternatively a larger print of the artwork can be printed on the back and front. Your child's name can be printed on the mug, just choose this option when placing your order online.

What happens if I miss the deadline?

If you miss the shop closure deadline, then you can still place an order, however, the school/organisation will not receive fundraising. Your order will be sent to your home address at a later date and you will also be charged postage. You will be asked to upload your child's artwork directly to us by using the link we will provide to you when you place your order. Please do not post your artwork as this will not be processed.

My child's artwork doesn't have a label on the reverse of it.

Without a unique artwork label stuck on the reverse of your child's artwork you will be unable to place your order. Please speak to the project organiser or class teacher who
